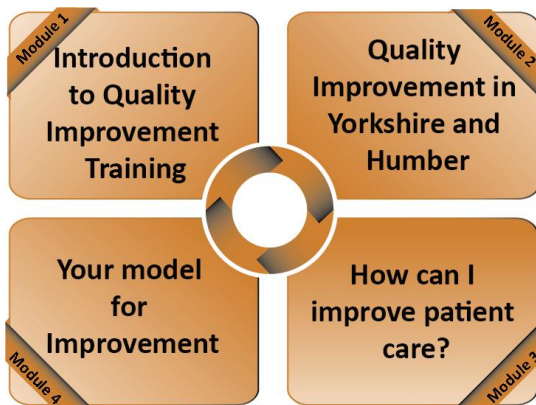


Bronze On-line Quality Improvement Training

Aim

To provide free e-learning entry level Quality Improvement training for everyone who works in health-and social care interested in supporting or delivering improvement.

Objectives

- To provide basic information about Quality Improvement approaches
- To offer practical examples of how quality improvement can be applied in practice
- To help trainees recognise that everyone has a role to play in Quality Improvement
- To provide a foundation knowledge prior to access to more advanced Quality Improvement training

Background information about Quality Improvement Training

Bronze training includes a broad spectrum of knowledge from an introduction to the basic concepts of 'Quality' and 'Quality Improvement' and to the Model for Improvement, to a more detailed understanding and application of some of the tools for quality improvement.

The content and materials for the Bronze on-line modules are based around material originally produced for the '1000 Lives Plus Campaign' by NHS Wales, where 1 in 7 staff have completed Bronze training (reported Jan 2015).



Content of Bronze on-line Training Modules



Module 1: Introduction to Quality Improvement Training (5 mins)

How Bronze fits in with other training, the core skills, and how to navigate the modules

Module 2: Quality Improvement in Yorkshire and Humber (30 mins)

Defines quality and its domains and relevance to healthcare

Module 3: How can I improve patient care? (30 mins)

Describes how to use some improvement tools, the importance of team working, and 'measuring for improvement'

Module 4: Your Model for Improvement (30 mins)

Explains how to apply the Model for Improvement

Modules 2, 3 and 4 end with a short quiz and the final module is followed by a short evaluation questionnaire. On completion of **ALL** of the modules, a certificate of completion can be printed off.
