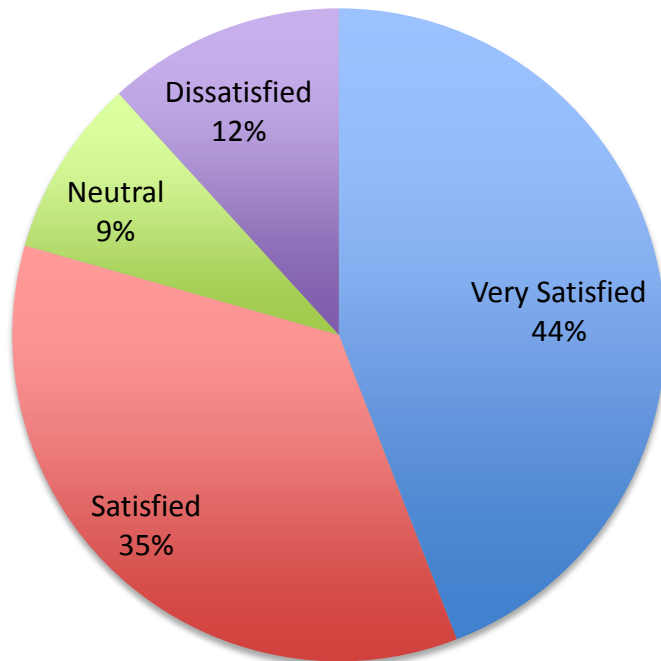

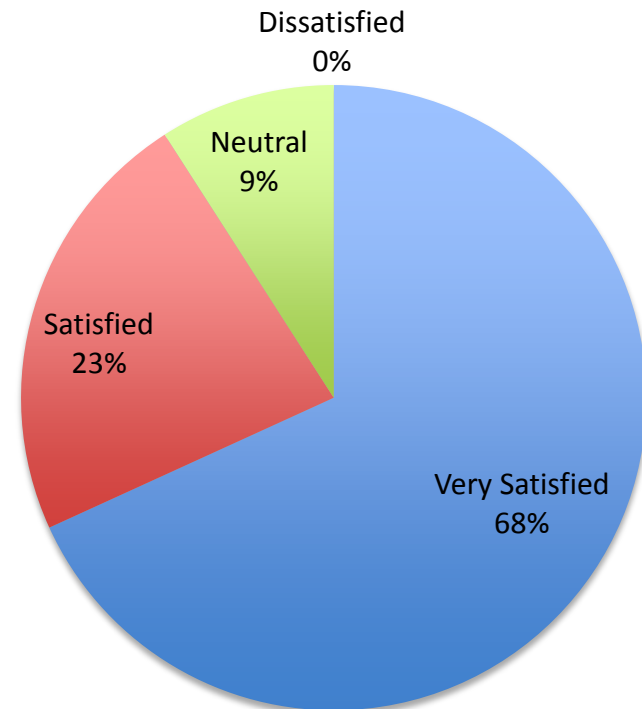
# Patient Satisfaction BTHFT

n=39

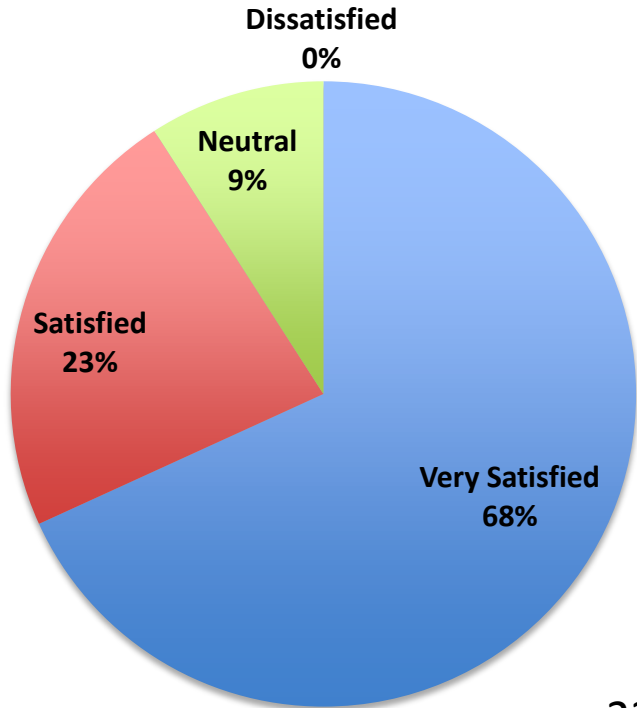
## Post-CARE



n=22

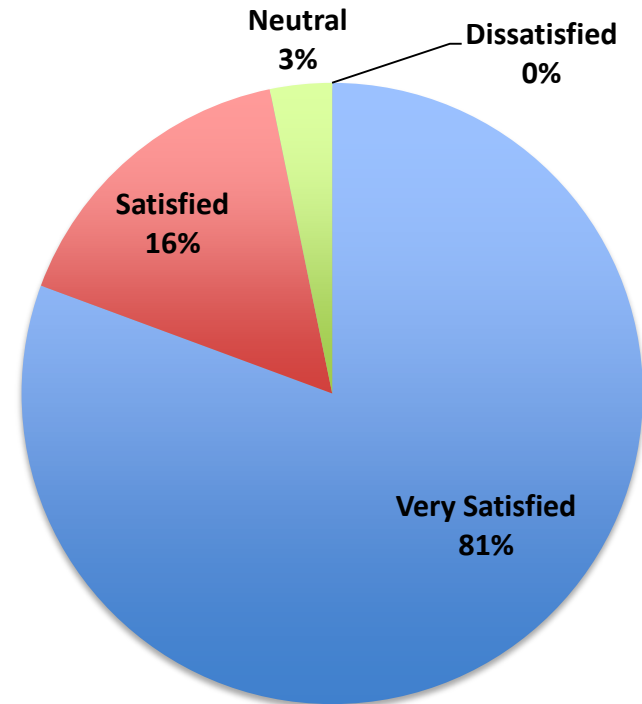
# Patient Satisfaction Phase 2

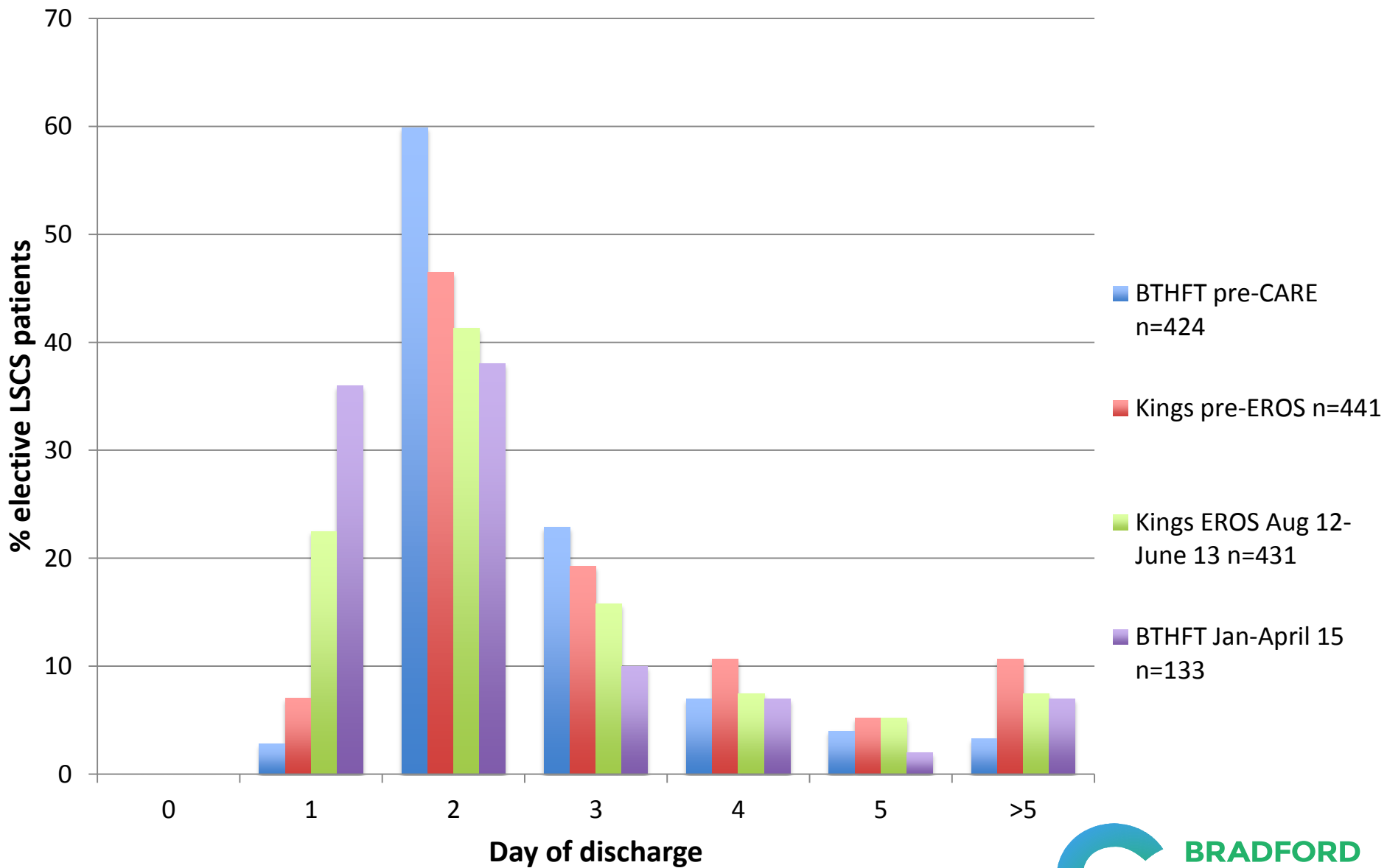
**Post-CARE 2015**



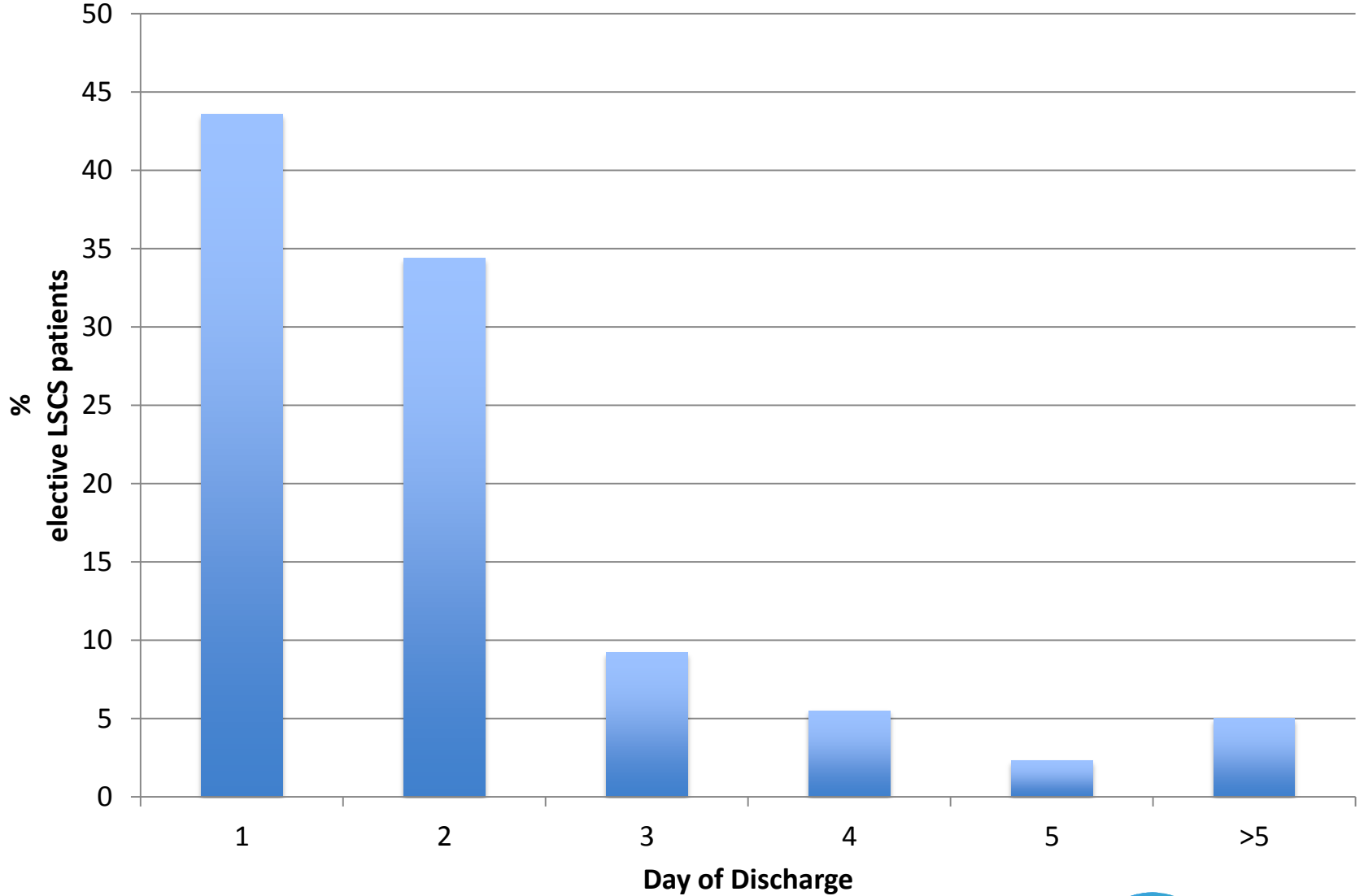
n = 31

# Financial Impact

total nights stay for cat 4 LSCS (excluding >5 days)	
pre-care	post care (04-09/15 x2)
1089	756

- 31% reduction nights stayed
- 333 nights/year
- £225/night
- Potential saving: £75,000
- LOS for other categories also reduced

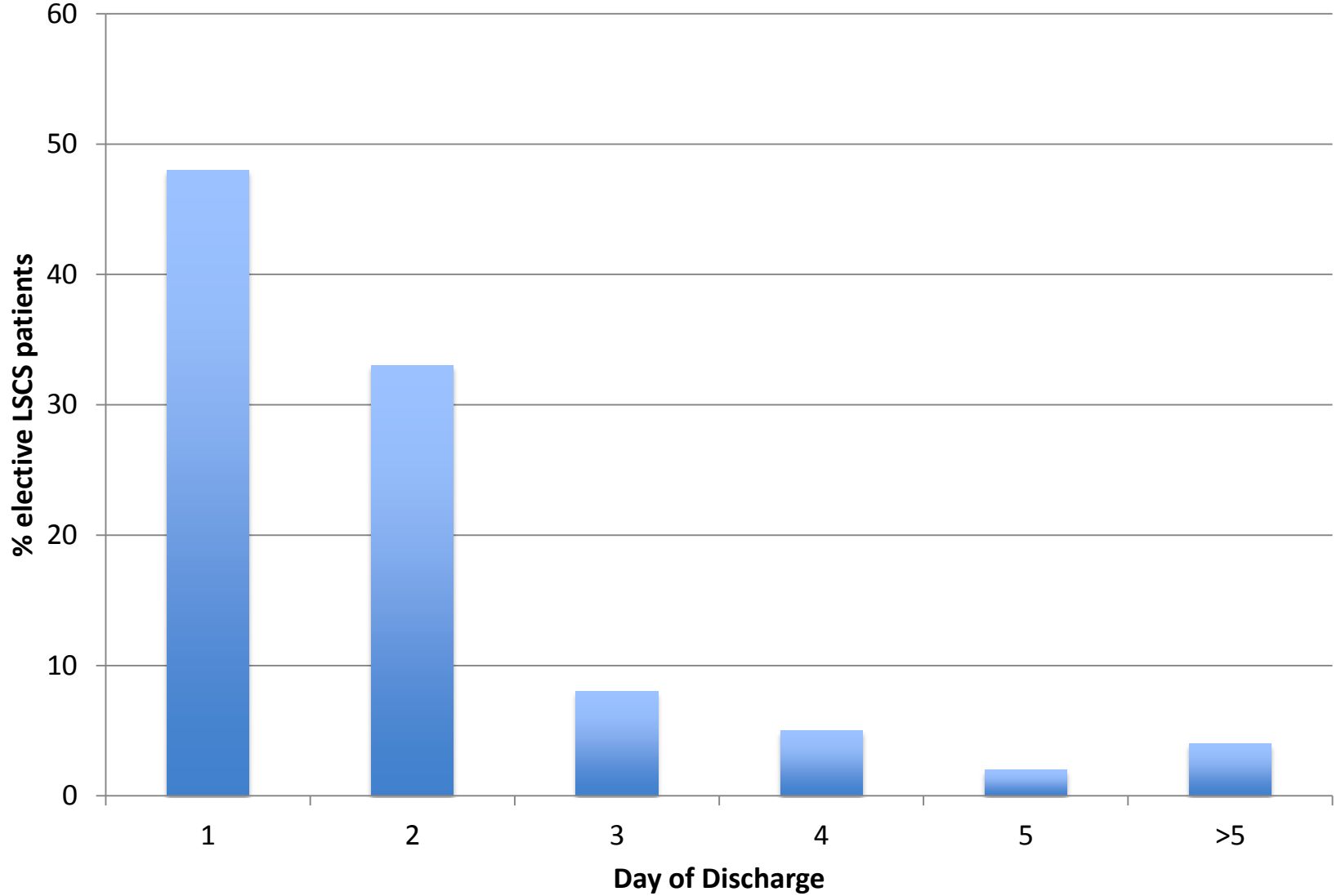
18% electives not able to be done during morning list

30	7	37

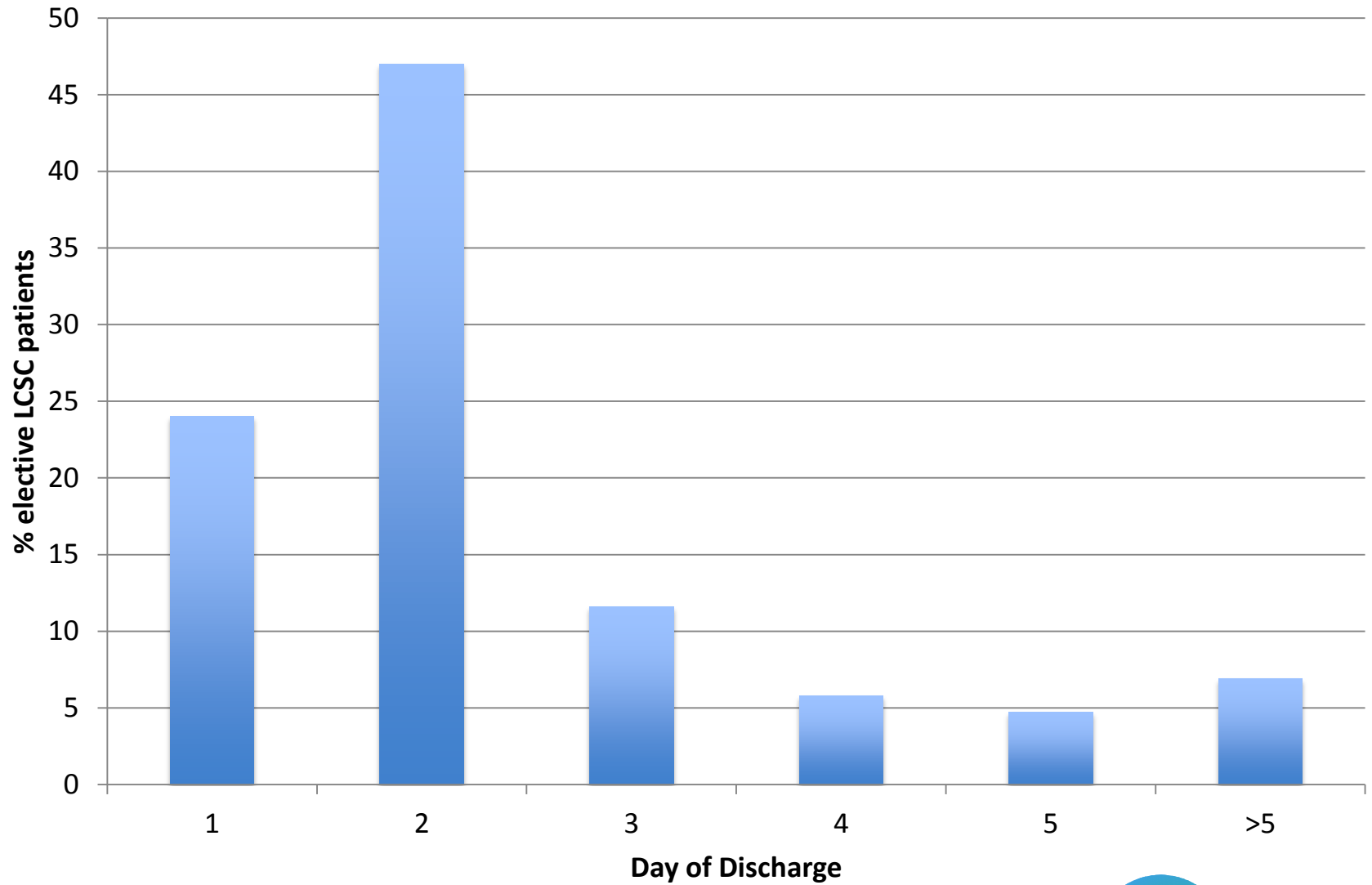
19% electives not able to be done during morning list!

- Dramatic reduction in LOS
- Improved patient satisfaction

# Future Developments

- Dedicated elective section list
  - Sufficient evidence that LOS significantly affected
  - Evidence of potential financial savings and improved patient satisfaction
