





### Best practice clinical case note review in mental health services

The Improvement Academy has developed **on-site training** for mental health or community organisations to review care using the Royal College of Psychiatrists template. Training is delivered by experienced trainers in a **'train the trainer'** format to ensure sustainability across the organisation, and supporting senior clinical reviewers to develop confidence in using these methods.
